SECTION 01

Event Overview

The Mile High 150 Expo is Colorado's flagship celebration of its 150th year of statehood — a two-day public event that fuses aviation heritage, live entertainment, patriotic ceremony, and family-friendly excitement into one unforgettable experience at Rocky Mountain Metropolitan Airport.

Produced by a coalition of Colorado aviation organizations — 1943 Events, the Commemorative Air Force Mile High Wing, and Mile High Air Boss — the Expo brings together rare warbird aircraft, a national music headliner, Cirque-style performers, and a spectacular 500-drone light show on the backdrop of the Front Range.

The Colorado Flyover Salute, a signature element of the Expo, will send a formation of historic and modern aircraft over the Front Range on both Friday evening and Saturday midday — visible to communities across the Denver metro area. It is a moment designed to stop the state in its tracks and look skyward together.

"Colorado is turning 150, and we wanted to mark that milestone in a way that's worthy of the state — something big, beautiful, and deeply Colorado," said the organizing team.

1943 Events

A Colorado-based event production company specializing in large-scale public events, aviation experiences, and patriotic commemorations. 1943 Events serves as the primary production lead for the Mile High 150 Expo.

CAF Mile High Wing

The Commemorative Air Force Mile High Wing is a Colorado unit of the Commemorative Air Force, dedicated to preserving and flying WWII-era aircraft for public education and inspiration. The Wing operates several historic aircraft and participates in airshows and events across the Rocky Mountain region.

Mile High Air Boss

The Mile High Air Boss (Creative Strategies Group) serves as the airshow director and aerial coordinator for the Expo, responsible for all flight operations, aerial choreography, and airspace coordination during the event.

Signature Aviation

Signature Aviation at BJC serves as a premier venue and ground operations partner for the Mile High 150 Expo, providing the Signature Legacy Ramp for the Saturday morning warbird display experience.

Rocky Mountain Metropolitan Airport (RMMA)

RMMA — one of Colorado's busiest general aviation airports — is the event venue, providing the runway, ramp, and terminal facilities that make the Expo's unique aviation-meets-entertainment format possible.
